1. [6 points] tectonic; divergent; convergent; transform; San Andreas; subduction

1. [3 points] Guatemala; El Salvador; Nicaragua
2. [5 points] Jamaica; Mexico, Belize, Cuba (accept in any order); Texas
3. [2 points] the wind speed of the hurricane will decrease; this happens because of frictional differences between land and water causing a disruption in the system, and also lack of ocean water from which to gain energy [award credit for partial answers or any reasonable equivalent]
