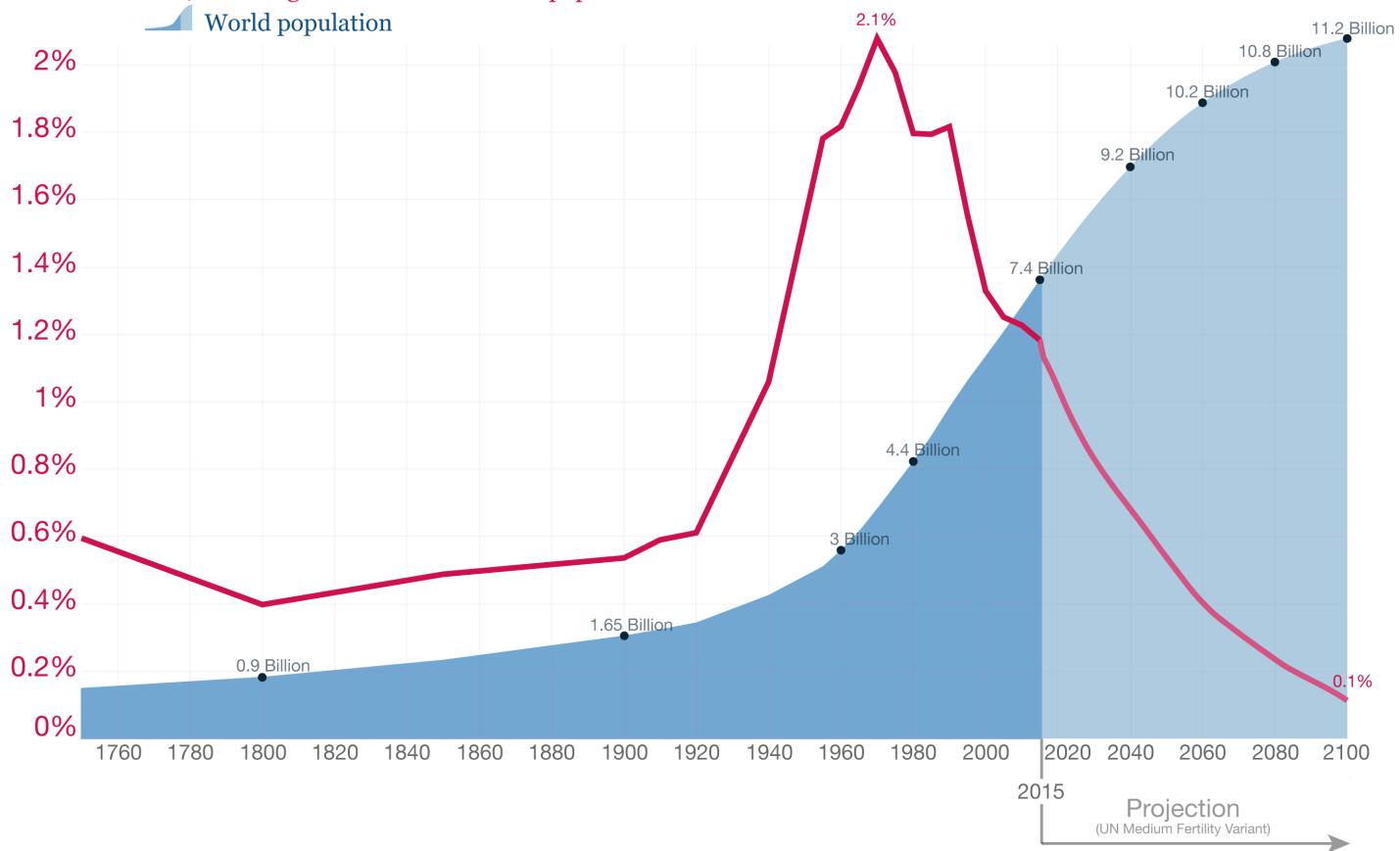

World population growth, 1750-2100

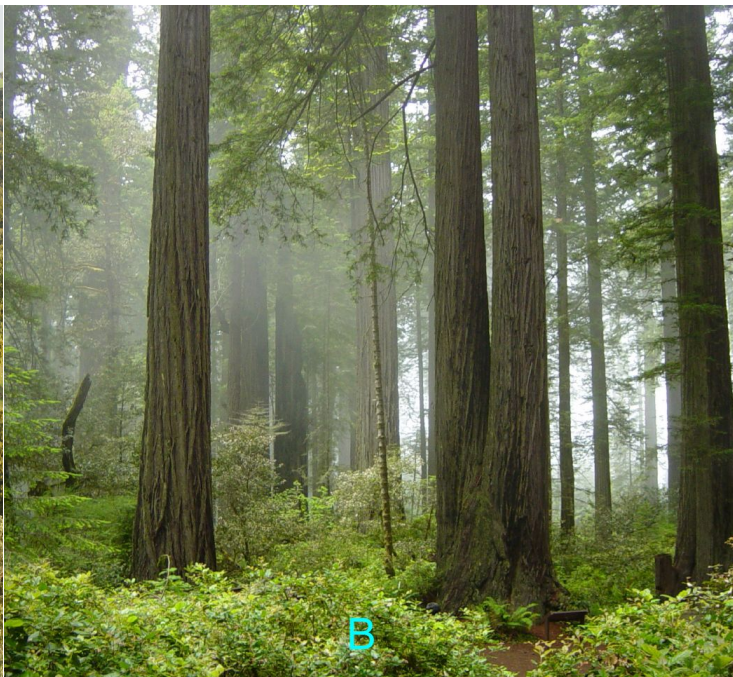
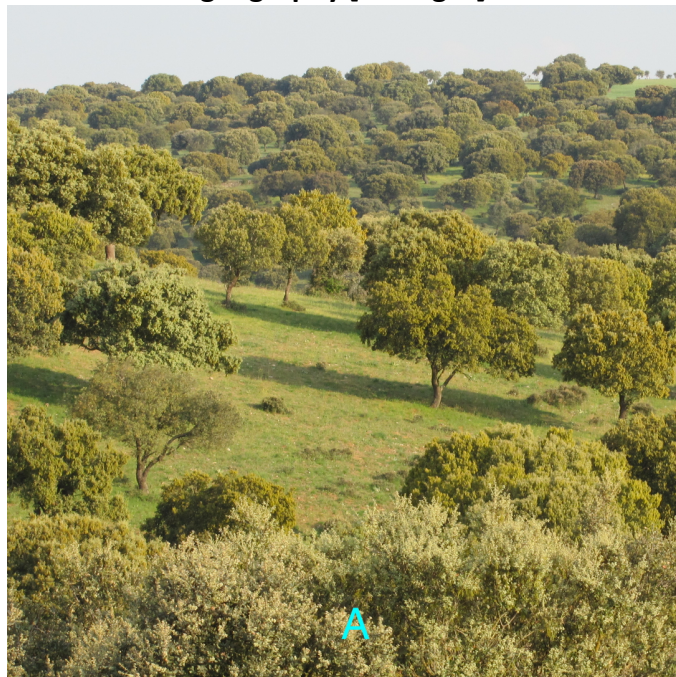
Annual growth rate of the world population

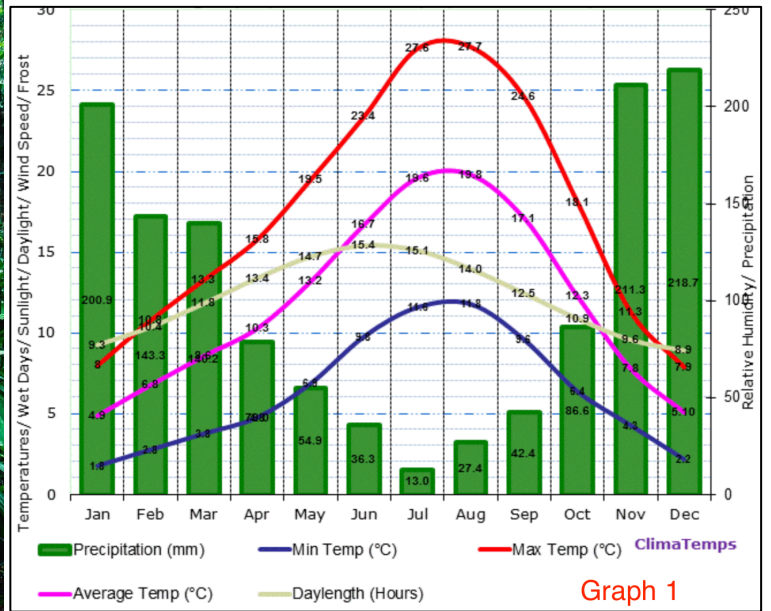

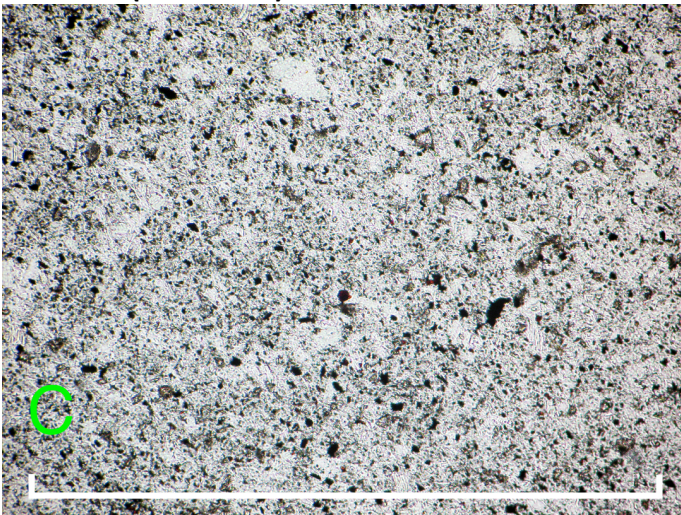
