- 5. What is one important way that species like wild hogs, lionfish, Asian carp, rusty crayfish and nutria might be used in a beneficial way in the United States that would also control their populations? (3 points)

- 13. In what direction does Tenaya Stream flow? (1 point)
- 14. Explain how you know based on the map that Tenaya Stream flows in the direction you chose. (2 points)
